COMMON HAZARDS



UNSAFE ACTS

- Taking shortcuts
- Ignoring procedures
- Improper use of tools/equipment
- Not wearing PPE



UNSAFE CONDITIONS

- Poor housekeeping
- Damaged equipment
- Obstructed walkways
- Unprotected hazards



HUMAN FACTORS

- Fatigue
- Distraction
- Stress
- Rushing the job



DID YOU KNOW?

Over 80% of workplace incidents are related to human behavior. Small actions can prevent big accidents.

KEY SAFETY RULES

- ✓ Follow all workplace procedures.
- ✓ Wear the required PPE at all times.
- ✓ Report hazards and incidents immediately.
- ✓ Do not take shortcuts.
- ✓ Stop work if conditions are unsafe.
- ✓ Look out for your colleagues.
- ✓ Keep your work area clean and organized.
- ✓ Work safely, go home safely.
